Supplies checklist

10 Gallon tank - approximate size 10 ½ wide by 19 ½ long by 12 ½ inches high
15 gallon tank - approximate size 12 ½ by 24 by 12 ½ inches high
20 gallon tank - approximate size 12 ½ by 24 by 16 inches high

Tank Chiller – able to keep temperature below 50° F Top for tank – if not supplied, make out of cardboard. Under gravel filter Filter stand pipe Pump head rated for 30 gallons Air intake tube for pump head Siphon gravel cleaner Net Turkey baster Thermometer De-chlor

15 pounds (5 quarts) gravel for 10 gallon tank 25 pounds (8 quarts) gravel for 15 or 20 gallon tank

Several 2-4" rocks Plug strip (supplied by teacher) Bucket (supplied by teacher) Tank cover to keep out light until fish are swimming (supplied by teacher) "Do not turn off or unplug" sign. (Supplied by teacher)

Clean tank thoroughly before and after use.

Clean gravel by washing thoroughly in a sieve. Boil gravel and rocks for 10 minutes before use. Set up tank at least a week before use. Make sure temperature stays at 50 degrees. Make sure air tube is outside tank. There must be a stream of bubbles coming out of the power head. Make cover for tank to keep out light (cardboard works well – students can decorate.) Attach "Do not turn off or unplug" sign to outlet and strip. (Supplied by teacher)
